Ideas For Your Weimaraner Puppy Packet  
As suggested by some of our own Breed fanciers

The items in an individual breeder's puppy packet may vary depending on location and/or individual puppy circumstances. How you package these items is up to you. Some breeders use decorative tote bags, colorful boxes or three ring binders; dog food companies such as Eukanuba provide an expandable file with dividers along with a puppy food sample.

### Puppy Packet Suggestions

- Copy of signed contract / purchase agreement / guarantee
- AKC registration form
- 3 to 5 generation pedigree, including all titles and OFA certifications
- Health clearance certificates for the sire and dam; e.g. OFA, CERF, Thyroid etc.
- Vaccination and worming protocols and schedule
- Copy of report by Dr. John Angles on Immune Mediated Problems & Vaccination in Weimaraners
- Information or articles explaining serious conditions that the Weimaraner breed is predisposed to e.g. bloat, immune mediated conditions & hip dysplasia
- Recommendations for Heartworm, flea & tick treatment
- Photos (Sire, Dam, Puppy)
- Information on Pet Health Insurance policies
- Books and/or pamphlets addressing puppy behavior and training issues
- Information on microchip and/or tattoo and their associated registries
- WCA membership application and copy of WCA Code of Ethics
- Futurity/Maturity booklet and nomination form and for show/field prospects
- List of local conformation, obedience and training clubs if applicable
- AKC informational pamphlets detailing various performance events
- Subscription order card for recommended magazines, e.g. AKC Gazette, Whole Dog Journal, etc.
- Feeding instructions
- Sample of puppy food (some manufacturers will provide to breeders free of charge)
- Crate training information and crate recommendations
- Grooming schedule, including instructions on nail grinding and clipping
- Pros & cons of early spay/neuter for companion pups
- List of your favorite educational websites
- List of poisonous plants and products; prevention and hotline number(s)
- Dog supply catalogs and websites
- Personalized puppy collar & leash
- At least 1 litter item with a familiar scent, i.e. toy or blanket that makes transition easier
- Breeder's business card
